## **Role Description: Council Member**

### **Eligibility**

1. All Executive Committee members and Council members must be active members in good standing, successfully complete at least three (3) University graduate credits during their term in office and may not academically withdraw during their term (AUGSA Bylaw, 8.10).
2. All Council members must reside in Canada (AUGSA Bylaws, 8.13).
3. Have served no more than four (4) terms on AUGSA Council, regardless of office held (AUGSA Bylaws, 10.3).

### **Commitment**

This role requires at least 6-12 hours per month dedicated to all responsibilities. Due to the nature of the role, the time commitment varies depending on the time of year.

### **Role and Responsibilities**

The Council Member's responsibilities include:

1. Submitting a report every month to the Council on portfolio activities.
2. Attending at least one (1) Council meeting per month;
3. Representing student concerns of an academic and non-academic nature to the institution;
4. Being a member of AUGSA Council sub-committees; and
5. Completing other tasks or projects assigned by the Executive Committee or Council.
