6.1 – ASEC/Ministry Roundtable (Info item)	 The VP External shared updates from ASEC's recent roundtable discussion with the Ministry of Enterprise and Advanced Education; the updates included: Mandatory non-instructional fees continue to be a major issue for students' associations, but the ministry continues to indicate they have no plans to regulate these fees The Ministry noted that there have been some discussions indicating that students may be willing to pay higher fees/tuition; the students' associations noted that the focus for students at the moment is predictable fees, rather than 	
	 Iarge, unpredictable increases. It was noted that the Post-Secondary Learning Act is still going to be opened in the fall session, but the timelines have been pushed back so students' associations will have more time to prepare their recommendations. 	
6.2 – IGNITE Focus Group (Info item)	The VP External and President shared an update on the focus group that followed the INGITE conference. The general consensus was that the event was a success, but there are major concerns among stakeholder groups about funding for post-secondary education.	
6.3 – PD Sessions	The VP External noted that, due to instructor availability at AU, the sessions originally planned for October will be pushed back—likely to early November. The first two sessions will be on effective poster
