6.1 Update on Advocacy activities	 VPEx Jamie: Mostly spoke to this in my report, but the meeting today with Minister Ceci (Finance), highlighted a tuition and funding review by the NDP Government. They want to review all facets of tuition and funding. Tuition should be capped at the Alberta CPI. Investing in education is the spearhead message. Government would like to see more access to tax credit programs. We also feel that access to disadvantaged students remains a priority along with more research funding. Other institutions get packages for acting as TA's and RA's but we have not had access to these dollars at AU. Funding Aboriginal Students had been capped on growth, but recently that cap (at the Federal level) has been removed so we asked for growth in this area. More internship programs is also on the advocacy agenda.
