

## The Role of Faculty Representative: What You Need to Know Before Elections



Faculty Representatives on Council shall be responsible to the association for the following:

- a) Attending and participating in all meetings of Council;
- b) Responding to AUGSA-related correspondence within 3 business days;
- c) Actively soliciting feedback and opinions from their constituency; and
- d) Adhering to all conditions as prescribed by their contract with the Association.

Additional responsibilities of Faculty Representatives may include:

- e) Be prepared to spend **at least 4 to 10 hours per month** dedicated to all responsibilities;
- f) Participate in monthly Council, subcommittee, and ad-hoc committee meetings; and
- g) Liaison with students and represent their concerns at Council, the University, and/or government.

Serving as a Faculty Representative is a fun and rewarding experience, a great way to give back to the university community, and an excellent opportunity to gain new skills.
